Qualifications

Qualified candidates are expected to have Ph.D., M.D., or equivalent degrees as well as postdoctoral training or equivalent research experience. Successful candidates are expected to establish and maintain competitive research program, and to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in English. Candidates must have a strong publication record in peer-reviewed journals, demonstrating their ability to conduct innovative and high-impact research. Applications from women and international scholars are strongly encouraged.

■ Evaluation Procedure

1st: Document screening

2nd: In-depth evaluation

3rd: Seminar and comprehensive review

4th: Final review and appointment decision by the College Faculty Appointment Committee and the Faculty Appointment Board (the appointment of tenured associate/full professors will be reviewed by the Faculty Appointment Board)

■ Submission of Documents

- Faculty application form (click to download or refer to the attached file)
 - : a summary of major achievements, lecture plan, research plan, consent for the collection and use of personal information
- Curriculum Vitae (free format)
- 5 representative publications
- Letters of Recommendation (3 letters for tenure-track assistant/associate professor positions; 6 letters for tenured associate/full professor positions). Only candidates who

pass the initial document-screening will be contacted to submit recommendation letters.

■ Notes

- Application documents should not directly or indirectly contain personnel information that may prejudice the committee members, such as gender, age, place of origin, family relationships, physical conditions (including height, weight, and appearance), personal assets, marital status, etc.
- The positions may not be filled if no qualified candidates are identified.
- Submitted documents will not be returned, and the appointment may be revoked if any part of the application is found to be inaccurate or falsified.
